We have become close with a wonderful, hardworking father named Hercio Malhuza.

He works as a house cleaner at house nr 5 in Xai Xai Eco Estate. He is a proud dad who works tirelessly and manages to feed his large family of six children. However, his income is not enough to cover the cost of his children's education. Hercio said that he knows good education is the only way his children will be able to break out of a life of poverty. He desperately wants a better future for them, and asked us if it is possible to help him with the education needs of his children as well as he saw us reaching out to others in need.

The children range from a 17-year-old boy down to a 1-year-old baby girl. Right now, the five older children urgently need school supplies and uniforms to stay in school, and the whole family is in need of decent clothing.

We felt convinced to look at families closest to us and support the very people that serve us first. Apart from school uniforms, school fees and books they need financial support for transport to get to the school. School Supplies will include notebooks, pens, pencils, backpacks.

We visited Hercio and his family at home and brought them some food. Only 4 of the six children were present. They live in a 4 roomed house, where Hercio and Regina have a small room, the children share one big room to sleep in and the 3rd and 4th room is a kitchen and lounge.

They shared their meal for that day with us and it was two small fishes and some bread. We were humbled and honoured and decided to support this family practically with the children's educational needs.
